



CONSENT TO DELIVERY OF DOCUMENTS BY E-MAIL
(California Civil Code § 4040(a)(2))

California law allows an association to deliver certain documents by e-mail if the recipient has consented in writing to that method of delivery. The documents permitted to be delivered by e-mail consist of those documents required to be delivered by individual delivery or individual notice (including the annual budget report, the annual financial statement review, and the annual policy statement) and those documents required to be delivered by general delivery or general notice (including notices of board meetings, notices of proposed rule changes, and notices of rule changes).
